 "..Covered me in my mother's womb", reveals that God put a body on me. Then I had to have been there.
- 2. **Psalms 119:73** This states that God made me and fashioned me in the womb. Would it not be a crime for someone to destroy what God is making? The womb is where we are made.
- **3. Genesis 16:11** What does it say? Thou art with **Fetus** or **Child?** Did God know if it was male or female? Has God chosen a name in advance?
- 4. **Exodus 21:21-23** Does the word child refer to a **Fetus** or **Fruit**? The word **mischief** in verse 23 must refer to death, if the punishment is Life for Life. This means that the Life in the womb **is equal** to the Life of an adult.
- 5. Job 10:11-12 For God to have clothed me, in my mother's womb, I must have been there. If God granted me Life, then I must have the RIGHT TO LIFE.
