

## How to Share the Gospel

To keep the Faith, you must give it away

### YOUR WAY OF LIFE IS IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER -

1. **Every child of God has two natures** – one is our natural sin nature that we were born with; the other is God’s divine nature that was given to us the moment we trusted in Christ. John 1:10-13; 3:1-7; Romans 8:9, 9:8; I Corinthians 15:44-50; Galatians 5:16-23; I Peter 1:18, 19, 23; I Peter 2:4
2. **To be a happy, fruitful Christian** you must allow the Holy Spirit to direct your life each day. You do this by your obedience to and faith in His Word. John 13:34,35; 14:21; 15:10-14; Romans 6:11-16; 12:1,2; I Corinthians 6:19,20; II Corinthians 5:14, 15; Galatians 5:16, 22, 23; Titus 2:11-15; II Peter 1:4-9. Especially note Hebrew 11 – the account of Old Testament believers who, through faith, did God’s will.
3. **Allow yourself time to grow.** No two children grow at the same rate, or in the same way. Neither do two spiritual children grow at the same pace. But do GROW.
  - Read, study and apply God’s Word to your life-daily. Psalm 1:1-3; 19:7-11; 119:9, 11, 105, 130; Jeremiah 15:16; Hebrews 4:12; 5:12-14; I Timothy 3:16, 17.

- Get in the habit of talking with your heavenly father about everything, big and small. Praise Him. Thank Him, Pray for others. Ask things for yourself. Don’t hold anything from Him. Psalms 103; Mark 11:24; Luke 11:5-10; 18:18; Philip. 4:6,7.
- Be sure to be involved in a good Bible-believing and Bible-teaching church. The teaching of God’s Word, plus the Christian fellowship available in such churches, will greatly strengthen your own faith. Psalms 119:63; 133:1; Hebrews 10:22-25.
- And by all means, begin sharing the wonderful gospel. It’s man’s only hope for time and eternity. Romans 10:13-17; Psalm 142:4, 106:23; Ezekiel 22:30; Acts 29:26,27; Proverbs 11:30; Daniel 12:3.

**IMPORTANT HIGHLIGHTS** In sharing the gospel: **ALWAYS** distinguish between God’s salvation by grace, and man’s efforts to try to save himself by his own works. Romans 11:6.

**NEVER** mix grace and works for salvation. Galatians 2:14, 21; 3:3; II Corinthians 11:3. 13-15.

**CLARIFY** the correct place for works - after one is saved. Works by a child of God should be out of a heart of gratitude for such a great salvation that we have in Christ. Ephesians 2:10; Titus 2:11-13; 3:8,8,14.

**NEVER COMPROMISE** There is only one gospel – Share IT. Galatians 1:6-10.
